## What is SNAP?

SNAP, or “Special Needs Activity Program” is the jewel of the City of Prescott’s Parks and Recreation Department. We provide social, creative and educational opportunities for Prescott-area adults with developmental and/or cognitive disabilities. SNAP participants are active members of their community through involvement in service projects, exploring their athletic abilities through exercise programs and sports, and creating new

## SNAP Programs
