What is Tri City Partnership?

What is the First Responder Smart Card Program?

Tri-City Partnership in cooperation with local first responders (Police, Fire, and EMS,) have created a program which offers training for first responders and how to better recognize and respond to the needs of an individual with special needs. It also provides training for parents and providers on when to call first responders and what happens once the call is made. When you register for the Smart Card Program first responders are alerted when a call is made to look for a Smart Card on the premises.

What is a Smart Card?

A universal form, displayed at your residence, that provides critical information to first responders concerning an individual with special needs. The only information needed to register for the First Responder Smart Card program is your name and address. Tri City Partnership maintains a strict confidentiality policy and shares this information only with local first responders.
